Dear Mishpocha and Friends,

God's Appointed Times invites you to join us for our 9th annual Feast of Tabernacles celebration – ***Dwelling with the Remnant!*** This year's celebration will be at Leisure Acres Campground, located at the foothills of the Smoky Mountains in beautiful Cleveland, GA. The feast begins on Wednesday night, September 22, with opening night in the Pavilion where we will wave branches before YAHWEH thus fulfilling the command ***"Now on the first day you shall take for yourselves the foliage of beautiful trees, palm branches and boughs of leafy trees and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days."*** **Leviticus 23:40**

Sukkot will continue through Saturday, October 2 as we enjoy **Simchat Torah** on Shabbat. During our time together we will sing, dance, learn, and fellowship; but most of all we will rejoice before YAHWEH. We will hold our annual Family Day cookout with the usual great fare of food, fellowship and lots of fun and games for the kids - - both young and old alike.

To attend Sukkot 2010 you must register. Our camp is closed to the public; there are no visitors. Each household attending Sukkot 2010 needs to complete their own registration form. You may request to camp near certain families or individuals, and we will attempt to meet your requests to the best of our ability once all parties are confirmed. The registration fee this year is \$40 per person for ages 13 and up and \$35 per person for ages 4-12. As always, kids younger than four are free. A LOT of work goes in to arranging these gatherings. We need your help and ask that you please register early to help us prepare. **All registration forms and final payments must be received no later than August 23, 2010.** Any registrations after that date are subject to a \$50.00 late fee and incomplete registrations forms will be returned unprocessed. Your registration will be confirmed once all fees are paid in full. Then, if you are camping with us, you will be assigned to a camp space on a *first-come, first-served* basis. Therefore, it is in your best interest to register, make full payment, and be confirmed as soon as possible. In particular, if you want to camp near someone or be in a particular part of the camp, your preference request is subject to your confirmation date. If you plan on staying in a local motel, you will want to make reservations as soon as possible with the motel.

Our refund policy is as follows: We understand that situations come up that cause a change of plans to attend Sukkot. To cancel your registration you must contact the God's Appointed Times office at (770) 287-0003.

Failure to contact us results in a forfeit of any fees paid. And, please note that:

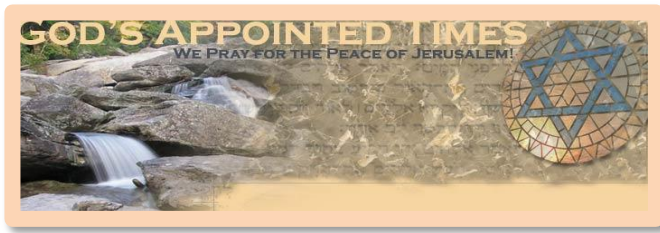
1. Refunds will be granted up until September 3, 2010, less a \$35 processing fee.
2. There are **no refunds** after September 3, 2010. We must order food, items for the campground, etc., by that date. The registration form requires your signature indicating your agreement with our registration and refund policy. And, you also agree to volunteer to serve in some capacity and be a full participant of the camp.

Opportunities to Volunteer at Tabernacles 2010: These are areas of need that provide opportunities for you to serve (more than one can be chosen). Please contact Tanya Orlando for more information.

Security - Security is a vital part of our camp. We ask that all able-bodied men volunteer in this area to be watchman on the wall while we are in the camp.

Kitchen - We will be need help with Shabbas dinner set-up and clean-up on 9/24 and again on 10/1, as well as prep, cooking and clean-up for the annual Family Day cookout.

Children's activities – Help needed with the activities and games on Family Day as well as if/when people volunteer for various workshops for the children. No special talents are required.

Camp Services - If you are a skilled electrician, carpenter, plumber, etc., this might be the category for you. People need help all the time with things in their campsite not covered by the campground. The one person who's been handling this gets spread pretty thin at times.

Coffee Corner - Looking for a few folks who will commit to help maintain the coffee corner by making fresh coffee each morning, and as needed throughout the day, and by making sure that the supplies are kept stocked and the area clean.

First Aid & Medical - Doctors, nurses, or EMTs who would like to assist in this area are critically needed. If you volunteer in this area you will be contacted by Tanya Orlando in advance of Tabernacles.

Camp Set-up and Tear Down - Please sign-up for this only if you are able to come at least 2 to 3 days early and/or stay 1 to 2 days later. You are responsible for paying for the extra days in camp as you serve in this much needed area.

Intercessory Prayer – A key area to volunteer! By volunteering you agree to commit to pray each day in the Tabernacle during our gathering.

Additionally, if you have a **special skill** or **talent** you would like to share please contact our office directly. Last year people came forward and volunteered for us to enjoy fun workshops like soap making, herbs and their uses to the body, as well as how to make flat bread over an open fire. We **strive** to plan a camp experience for every member of the family to enjoy. Some will be assembling for the first time and some have been with us for years. We want the camp to be **exciting** and **spiritually rewarding** for you, but most of all we want it to be **pleasing** to Father and a place where He can **dwell** among us! So, in addition to your Sukkah (tent, pop-up, trailer, or motor home), plan to bring a **joyful** heart and make Feast of Tabernacles 2010 the best gathering ever!
